I've just returned on Tuesday from a sixteen day mission to Siliguri and Tripura, either side of Bangladesh. The main purpose of the visit was to train students at a Discipleship School of Supernatural Ministry (DSSM). The idea is to teach the ministry of Jesus, expecting that humanly-impossible actions follow.

The trip began, for me, with a visit to some people I met on Facebook, who are planting churches in Siliguri. I spent time with two of their five congregations - one of them on the Jogmaya Tea Estate, which was

beautiful. We saw a significant number of physical healings and left the churches deeply touched and wanting more.

The DSSM was very powerful and most, perhaps all, students found it life-changing. Training them in ministry, we went into nearby villages in the evenings where, again, the power of God was present to heal as we prayed for numerous people.

The 'icing on the cake' was the healing of a Hindu lady from London on the flight back to Heathrow. She was having trouble with circulation and put her legs up on her husband's knees. I offered to swap seats, but also took a risk and offered to pray. She was healed immediately and was very happy, wanting to hear more about Jesus. I didn't want to hide this stuff away, so here it is!
